In 2020 a bill legislating CHW certification was on track for approval by the Oklahoma State Legislature, but didn't pass before the session was cut short due to COVID-19.






The Route 66 CHW Training drew participants from across the state and from a variety of organizations including public health, hospitals and health care systems, nonprofits, and universities.













